Baltimore County resources that can provide help for the homeless are listed on the newly updated "Street Card" created by the Baltimore County Public Library in cooperation with Baltimore County Communities for the Homeless.

By using the folded, wallet-sized listing, homeless people can locate providers of shelter, legal assistance, job skill training and employment, food, health care, clothing and income assistance.
