Ladies and Gentlemen,

This addendum will provide answers to the questions proposed in regard to the Bar Code Labels and RFID Tags RFP.

Q1. Do the RFID tags have to be on UPM [labelstock] or can we bid alternate?

A1. We will be willing to accept durable, comparable labelstock that will perform to the same standard.

Q2. Is the previous Bar Code Label and RFID Tag RFP Contract available for viewing?

A2. We do not post or share the final executed version of the contract. Our sample contract can be located on our [web page \(www.bcpl.info/about-us/bid-opportunities\)](http://www.bcpl.info/about-us/bid-opportunities) and the total amount of the previous contract was \$95,000 (\$3,500 barcodes; \$91,500 RFID tags).

Q3. [Is it expected that] each bar code will have distinct numbers?

A3. Yes – each bar code must be distinct, unique and as specified in the RFP, in sequential order.

All addenda created will be incorporated into the final contract and must be acknowledged in all proposals. The form of acknowledgement is included in the proposal and failure to sign and submit this form may result in your proposal being rejected.
