

Cloud Library for Nook Color and Nook Tablet




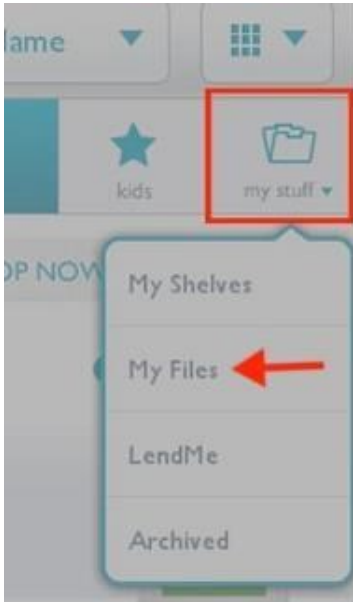
The Nook AppStore has been discontinued by Barnes & Noble and there is no longer a way to download or update apps to the Nook Color and Nook Tablet. Newer Nooks (Samsung Galaxy tabs, Nook HD and Nook HD+) can continue to access to Google PlayStore to download the Cloud app but the Nook Color and Nook Tablet cannot.

If you already have the Cloud Library app, it should continue to work. However, due to this change, Cloud Library is no longer able to update the app for Nook Color or Tablet and cannot provide support if the app fails.

If you do not have the app or if it stops working, you can use a Windows or Mac computer with the Cloud Library app installed and transfer (side load) Cloud Library e-books to your Nook Color or Nook Tablet. NOTE: audiobooks from Cloud Library cannot be side loaded and are not accessible this way.

Please follow the instructions below to do this.

1. Turn on your device and computer *then* connect the device to your computer with a USB cable.
2. Install the Cloud app for Windows: (<http://www.yourcloudlibrary.com/index.php/en-us/get-the-app/windows>)
or Mac (<http://www.yourcloudlibrary.com/index.php/en-us/get-the-app/mac>).
3. Transfer the titles to the device using the Cloud Library app. For instructions on transferring the titles see <http://www.bcpl.info/sites/default/files/images/findmaterials/pdf/find-materials-downloadables-ebooks-3m-pc-app-and-ereaders-nookand-kobo-2013-8.pdf>
4. Eject the Nook Color from the computer and you are ready to read your books.
5. Log on to the Nook and tap the home button. 
6. Tap on the **library** icon in the Nook's home menu.
7. Tap on **My stuff** and choose **My Files** from the drop down menu.
8. The titles you transferred should be listed under My Files.



9. Tap on the title to open and read.
